

## **Golden Spade Awards – Residential Landscape Promotional Program Official Rules**

The Golden Spade Awards is a Landscape Promotional Program that recognizes the many beautifully landscaped residential front yards in Prince Albert and the people who put in the time to get them looking so amazing. For this year, there will also be a special draw for front yards that have a Red and White Canada 150 theme.

### **How the program works**

If you have a friend or neighbor that lives in the City limits that has a beautifully landscaped front yard, you can nominate them for a Golden Spade Award. Just fill out the online form at [www.citypa.ca](http://www.citypa.ca) and submit a photo.

### **How the yards and residents are recognized**

Front yards that are nominated will receive letter from the Mayor Prince Albert and small token of appreciation for the efforts of the homeowner to make their yards and neighbourhood beautiful. Each yard nominated will also be put into a draw for one of three prizes to a home and garden centre. There will also be a special “Red and White” category for Canada 150. Only those with Red and White themed yards will be entered into this draw.

### **Prizes**

Four \$100 gift cards to a home and garden centre will be awarded with one of the four categories reserved for a red and white category. If there are no yards submitted that qualify for the red and white category, a fourth draw will be made at random from those yards nominated.

### **Deadlines**

The program will close for nominations on August 15, 2017.

### **Publication**

The City of Prince Albert reserve the non-exclusive right to publish any entry and/or use any entry in promotional materials. By submitting a nomination through the City of Prince Albert Landscape Promotion Program entrant grants the City the unrestricted and non-exclusive rights to use photograph(s) for any purpose. This includes, but is not limited to, publishing your photograph(s) in print or electronic form for promotional purposes without further compensation, and the right to use the photographers name as a credit along with the photograph. This also includes the right to share the photo for use and publication by affiliate organizations. The photographer must own all rights to any photographs entered in this program.

### **Personal Information**

Personal information collected through this program is in accordance with *The Local Authority Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (LAFOIP)* and will only be used for the purpose for which it was collected. The information submitted through this program will be used in the administration of this program as described in the program official rules. The personal information of the person nominated or the person nominating will only be shared for promotional purposes with prior verbal or written consent of the applicable person(s).
