- **Dry Cell Batteries** (single use and rechargeable Nickel Cadmium, Nickel Hydride, Alkaline, Lithium, Ion, Mercury Silver Oxide and Metal Button)
- **Wet Cell Lead Batteries** (used in electronics, emergency lighting systems, backup power sources, and motorized equipment)
- **Anti-freeze**

Landfill Voucher Program

All households that pay a sanitation fee as of January 1st qualify for the **Landfill Voucher Program**. If you did not pay a sanitation fee until after January 1st you will be eligible on the next renewal date which is the first day of the following year.

To redeem a **voucher**, you will need to bring a recent (from within the last 3 months) original water utility/sanitation bill for an active account and present it to the attendants at the landfill. They will search the name and enter the number of vouchers used on your visit.

One voucher is equivalent to the minimum charge for a load equal to or under 150 kg. You may use more than one voucher at a time, if your load is greater than 150 kg or pay the difference.

Four vouchers a year are applied to each account. Any unused vouchers from a prior year, cannot be applied to the next calendar year. The program does not apply to appliances containing Freon (fridges, deep freezers, air conditioners, etc.), tires, or asbestos. To check if an item will have additional charges please call (306) 953-4900.

Any original water utility/sanitation bill, for an active account, is considered a voucher card and will be accepted without identification requested. The City will not mediate any disputes arising, due to vouchers that were utilized without the knowledge of the account holder.

Sanitation Collection

Garbage and Recycling is scheduled on set days for each area. For areas with blue and green roll out containers please follow the collection calendar available on www.citypa.ca or by calling (306) 953-4900. For areas with large blue or green containers in the alley these may be emptied on a separate rotation.

*Please recycle paper, magazines, plastics (with recycle symbol, numbered 1 to 7), cardboard and boxboard, paper egg cartons, clean tin and aluminum cans, rinsed plastic soda and water bottles, cardboard and rinsed milk containers (plastic or cardboard) in these bins. **NO Glass***

Paper, Cans and Plastic Recycling

Items acceptable in the blue bins:

- ✓ Newspapers, flyers, inserts, junk mail
- ✓ Flattened cardboard, boxboard and paperboard (cereal boxes, milk cartons (rinsed), egg cartons, shoeboxes)
- ✓ Paper (office bond, photocopier, bags)
- ✓ Tin cans, rinsed, labels can be left on
- ✓ Plastics (rinsed milk containers, soft drink and water bottles, household containers (must have recycling symbol, numbering 1 to 7))



Please clean containers before placing in bin.

Not acceptable in blue bins:

- ✗ Paper that has been soiled or contaminated
- ✗ Household garbage and food
- ✗ Styrofoam or other foam packing materials
- ✗ Plastics that do not display the recycle symbol and a number 1 through 7
- ✗ Glass materials
- ✗ Yard waste, wood and concrete
- ✗ Clothing and textiles
- ✗ Animal fecal matter
- ✗ No Paint
- ✗ No Needles

Yard Waste Collection

From spring until fall, weather permitting, yard waste will be picked up. Collection is the same day as recycling pick up and placed at least 3 feet from the blue bin. During peak periods, yard waste pick up may take extra days to collect.



Branches tied in bundles less than 1.0 metre in length will also be collected.

Unlimited bags will be collected each pick up with no bag weighing more than 25 kg (55 pds).

Larger branches must be cut to less than 1 meter in length and tied into bundles or it will not be collected. Absolutely **NO bags of dirt** will be collected.

Automotive Recycling

The City of Prince Albert Landfill accepts used motor oil, filters, oil containers, anti-freeze only free of charge. Up to 20 litres 5 filters or 10 litres of anti-freeze per visit.

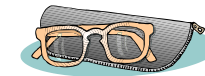


SaskPower
