

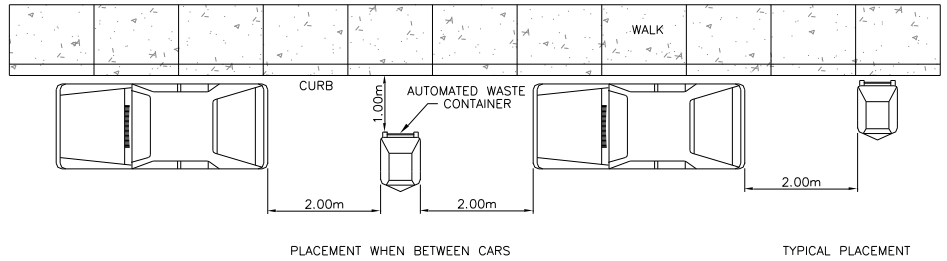


Waste Collection Information

- ⇒ Refer to the attached schedule for your collection days
- ⇒ Containers should be placed out **by 7:30 a.m.** for collection
- ⇒ Collection is made between 7:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on scheduled days
- ⇒ Place containers out for pick-up **ONLY** when full
- ⇒ Return the rollout containers to your property from the lane or curb no later than noon the day following collection day
- ⇒ **Please do not dispose of yard waste in the garbage or recycle containers**

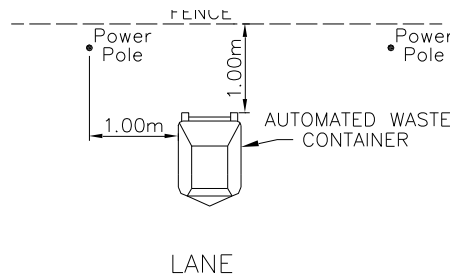
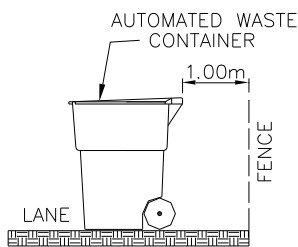
Container Placement FRONT STREET

Where and how you place your container is key to the success of front street collection. The truck's mechanical arm needs unobstructed access to "reach out" to your container. If placing container between 2 vehicles, ensure it is 1 metre from curb.



Container Placement REAR LANE

Containers need to be placed away from fences, garages, power poles and overhanging trees.

HOURS 8:00 AM – 6:30 PM Monday to Saturday
CLOSED Sundays - Christmas Day and New Year's Day

ITEMS ACCEPTED FREE OF CHARGE

ECO CENTRE will accept 20 litres of used oil per visit, 5 oil filters per visit, oil containers & anti-freeze
LANDFILL will accept automotive batteries, yard waste & branches

Recycling Program

What is acceptable in the blue recycling container:

- 👉 Newspapers, Office bond – Photocopier paper etc.
- 👉 Cardboard – **Flattened**
- 👉 Boxboard – Cereal boxes, Shoe boxes
- 👉 Rinsed cardboard & plastic milk containers
- 👉 Paper egg cartons (not Styrofoam)
- 👉 Plastic shopping bags
- 👉 Plastic soft drink & water bottles
- 👉 Rinsed tin cans, soft drink & beer cans

What is NOT acceptable in the blue recycling container:

- 👉 Household garbage & food
- 👉 Styrofoam or other packing materials
- 👉 Paper that has been soiled or contaminated
- 👉 Yard Waste – including grass & leaves
- 👉 Scrap metal and glass materials
- 👉 Wood & Concrete (construction material)
- 👉 Clothing & textiles
- 👉 Kids toys of any kind

Yard Waste Collection

Yard waste collection will commence in the spring depending on weather conditions. The City will pick up the yard waste in yard waste paper bags only. Collection will be on the same day as recycle collection. Watch for advertising and news releases on the City web page. The City may extend the collection day to include the day before and the day after the regularly scheduled collection day in the event of severe weather, unusually large volumes, or other circumstances that require the collection day to be extended in order to provide the base level of service.

For Your Information:

- **Yard Wastes include leaves, branches, grass clippings**
- Yard waste paper bags are available for sale at many local retailers
- **Place the paper bags 3 feet from the recycle container, by 7:30 am for collection**
- Only paper bags and bundles will be picked up
- Unlimited bags (weighing no more than 20 kilograms) will be collected every two weeks
- Branches tied in bundles less than 1.0 metre in length will also be collected
- Bags containing garbage will not be picked up
