Also, 1,210,000 lbs. of yard waste are diverted to the compost facility.

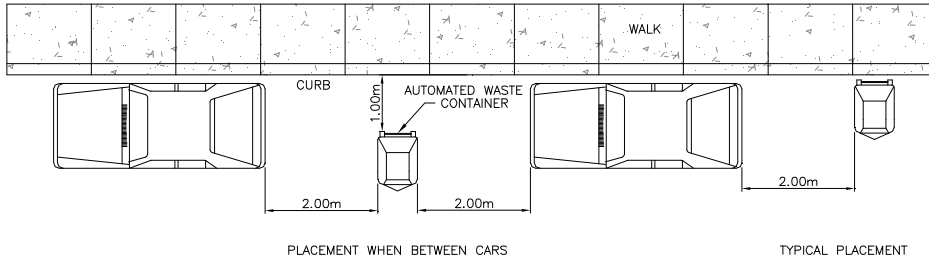
## Waste Collection Information



- ⇒ Refer to the attached schedule for your collection days
- ⇒ Containers should be placed out **by 7:30 a.m.** for collection
- ⇒ Collection is made between 7:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on scheduled days
- ⇒ Place containers out for pick-up **ONLY** when full
- ⇒ Return the rollout containers to your property from the lane or curb
- ⇒ By 6:00 pm the day after they are emptied
- ⇒ **Please do not dispose of yard waste in the recycle containers**

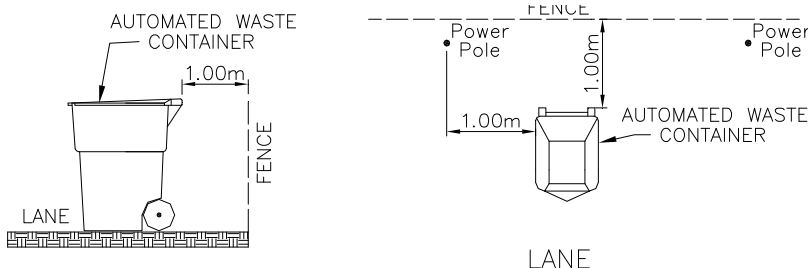
### Container Placement FRONT STREET

Where and how you place your container is key to the success of front street collection. The truck's mechanical arm needs unobstructed access to "reach out" to your container. If placing container between 2 vehicles, ensure it is 1 metre from curb.



### Container Placement REAR LANE

Containers need to be placed away from fences, garages, power poles and overhanging trees.



### **LANDFILL INFORMATION**

**LOCATION** N on Hwy #2 to 15 Street NW – turn left – watch for signs

**HOURS** 8:00 AM – 6:30 PM Monday to Saturday

**CLOSED** Sundays - Christmas Day and New Years Day

#### ITEMS ACCEPTED FREE OF CHARGE

**ECO CENTRE** will accept used oil, oil filters & oil containers

**LANDFILL** will accept automotive batteries and yard waste

### Recycling Program

**What is acceptable in the blue recycling container:**

- ☞ Newspapers, Office bond – Photocopier paper etc.
- ☞ Cardboard – Flattened
- ☞ Boxboard – Cereal boxes, Shoe boxes
- ☞ Rinsed cardboard & plastic milk containers, juice boxes, etc.
- ☞ Paper egg cartons (not Styrofoam)

**What is NOT acceptable in the blue recycling container:**

- ☞ Paper in plastic bags
- ☞ Paper that has been soiled or contaminated
- ☞ Garbage
- ☞ Yard Waste – including grass & leaves
- ☞ Other plastic, metal and glass materials
- ☞ Wood & Concrete

### Yard Waste Collection

After May long weekend through to the last week in October, weather permitting, the City will pick up yard waste placed in **Clear Plastic Bags**. Collection will be on the same day as recyclable collection. Occasionally during peak periods, compost pickup takes extra days to collect.

### **For Your Information:**

- Yard Wastes include leaves, branches, grass clippings
- **Clear bags** are available for sale at many local retailers
- Place the compost bags **3 feet from the recycle container**, by 7:30 am for collection
- Only clear bags and bundles will be picked up
- Up to 6 bags (weighing no more than 25 kilograms) will be collected every two weeks
- Branches tied in bundles less than 1.0 metres in length will also be collected
- Bags containing garbage will not be picked up
