Metercards

Metercards offer a cashless way to use the new parking meters in downtown Prince Albert (\$0.25, \$1 and \$2 coins are still accepted).

Where to Buy:

Your first metercard comes preloaded with \$20. They are reloadable in \$10 increments (up to \$100) and can be purchased at City Hall - 1084 Central Ave.

A one-time \$5.00 fee is required for every new Metercard purchased. Once the card is empty, you can reload it to avoid paying another charge.

How it Works:

Adding Time to the meter:

1. **Insert Card** firmly into the parking meter card slot with the chip side facing down.
2. Parking meter will indicate remaining card value
3. Parking meter will flash and then display the max time allowed on the parking meter or the max amount of time the card can purchase with the balance remaining on the card.
4. **Remove Card**

Note: If the card does not work on the first try, please re-insert into the parking meter slot and try again. Keep card in long enough to program the meter.

Recovering Time from the meter:

1. **Insert Card** firmly into the parking meter card slot with the chip side facing down.
2. The meter will credit unused time rounded up to the nearest \$.25. Be sure to leave card in slot long enough to show 0:00 and the amount remaining on the card.
3. **Remove Card**

Important: Always remember to reinsert your card in the meter before leaving your parking spot to ensure you credit any unused time back to your card.
