### **ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT – BYLAW NO. 14 OF 2013**

Public Notice is hereby given that the Council of The City of Prince Albert intends to adopt Bylaw No. 14 of 2013 to amend Bylaw No. 1 of 1987, known as The City of Prince Albert Zoning Bylaw.

**Reason for Amendment:** Through Bylaw No. 14 of 2013, text amendments will be made to the Zoning Bylaw No.1 of 1987, to add definitions for 'Pulp Mills and Associated Uses' and 'Temporary Project Accommodation' to Section 33: Glossary, to add 'Temporary Project Accommodation' as a new discretionary use in the M1: Heavy Industrial zone and add new regulations to Section 21.2: Temporary Buildings, Structures and Uses to regulate 'Temporary Project Accommodation' developments. The intent of the text amendments described above are to allow for temporary project accommodations within the M1: Heavy Industrial zone subject to receiving development permit approval and meeting specific regulations.

If you would like your written submission reviewed by members of Council prior to the meeting, it would be preferable to provide your submission by 4:45 p.m. on Tuesday, March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2013.**
