PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE PORTABLE SIGN BYLAW

Planning and Development Services will be holding an open house regarding proposed changes to the Portable Sign Bylaw. The open house is intended for members of the public to ask questions and provide feedback and commentary in general regarding portable signs.

Notable changes include:

- An amendment that allows fines to be issued for garage sale signs that can be applied to a tenant rather than just the property owner.
- An amendment that allows a sign in violation to be ticketed for each day it remains in violation.
- An amendment that allows for the placement of non-profit signs on site as long as they meet minimum separation requirements.
