

PUBLIC NOTICE

PROPOSED BYLAW AMENDMENT – BYLAW NO.6 OF 2014

Public Notice is hereby given that the Council of The City of Prince Albert intends to amend Bylaw No. 22 of 2010, known as The City of Prince Albert Portable Sign Bylaw. The proposed Bylaw No. 6 of 2014 will amend Bylaw No. 22 of 2010 Portable Sign Bylaw with the following:

- (a) By amending Section 3(l) to read as follows: "Corner visibility triangle" means a triangular area formed on a corner site by the two street property lines and a straight line which intersects them 3 metres from the corner where they meet";
- (b) By replacing the words "Economic Development and Planning" with the words "Planning and Development Services" throughout;
- (c) By amending Section 3(d) to read as follows: "A-Board sign" means a self-supporting sign which is set upon, but not attached to, the ground and has no external supporting structure and does not exceed 1.2 square meters in area";
- (d) By deleting Section 9(a)(vi);
- (e) By adding the following text under Section 7: "That a valid City Of Prince Albert Business License number be provided for the business to be advertised";
- (f) By amending Section 16(a) to read as follows; "The following regulations shall apply to all signs in both the C1 and C2 zoning Districts";
- (g) By amending Section 21 Portable Signs General to read as follows: "Each portable sign shall have a valid sign permit issued. Portable signs shall not exceed 4.1 square metres (45 square feet) per side and not be taller than 3 metres (10 feet) above grade. Portable signs must maintain a minimum 20 metre separation on the same site. Council may, at its discretion, set the required distance separation for strip malls to allow greater signage. Portable signs are only permitted in off-street parking areas if the parking spaces are in excess of the Zoning Bylaw requirements";
- (h) By adding a new Section 23(d) to read as follows: "No property owner, tenant or occupant of a property or abutting property, shall cause, allow, permit, place or consent to the placement of a portable sign on city owned property or public property, which said sign advertises a yard sale or garage sale. The address contained on the portable sign is deemed to belong to the property owner, tenant or occupant, where the sale is advertised on the sign";
- (i) By adding a new Section 30(g) to read as follows: "When a sign is too large to be removed by an individual or may require the use of equipment to remove, the owner of a sign notified that the sign must be brought into compliance will all aspects of the Bylaw within a 48 hour period. Failure to achieve compliance within a 48 hour period will result in the issuance of a summary ticket as defined under Section 31(b) of this bylaw, for each day the sign remains in contravention of this bylaw. These fines will be held valid on any given day wherein a sign remains in contravention as of 1 pm of each day concurrent to first day a ticket is issued";

- (j) By amending Section 19(b)(iii) to read as follows; “Non-profit and community based signs placed on designated properties are located in accordance with all other regulation within this bylaw”.

Therefore, City Council, at its meeting to be held on Monday, June 23th, 2014 at 5:00 p.m., will consider ALL submissions either orally or written respecting the above application until that date and time. In accordance with City Council’s Procedure Bylaw No. 10 of 2005, all written submissions must be signed and provided to the City Clerk. If you would like your written submission reviewed by members of Council prior to the meeting, it would be preferable to provide your submission by 4:45 p.m. on Tuesday, June 16th, 2014.
