

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **PORTABLE SIGN BYLAW BYLAW NO. 38 OF 2015**

Public Notice is hereby given that the Council of The City of Prince Albert intends to consider a bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 22 of 2010 known as The Portable Sign Bylaw.

**Reason for Amendment:** Through Bylaw No. 38 of 2015, The City of Prince Albert is proposing changes to regulation wherein:

1. Certain types of signage will be allowed for homebased businesses;
2. Flag signage will be permitted if maintained and contained within a site;
3. A provision to allow City Council to apply regulations to signage not currently defined within the bylaw;
4. Size limitations previously not referenced are stated for certain signage types;
5. That both sign company and business owner must be licensed; and
6. Housekeeping items such as definitions and format.

**PUBLIC HEARING** – City Council will hear all submissions on the proposed bylaw and all persons who are present and wish to speak on:

**Monday, November 30, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. in City Hall Council Chambers, 1084 Central Avenue, Prince Albert, SK.**

If you would like your written submission reviewed by members of Council prior to the meeting, you are required to provide your submission by 4:45 p.m. on Tuesday, November 24, 2015.**
