

## **PUBLIC HEARING**

### **ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT – Bylaw No. 25 of 2016**

Public Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Prince Albert intends to adopt Bylaw No. 25 of 2016 to amend Bylaw No. 1 of 1987, known as the City of Prince Albert Zoning Bylaw.

**Reason for the Amendment:** On June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2016 City Council gave 1<sup>st</sup> reading to Bylaw No. 25 of 2016. The purpose of this amendment is to add the use “Animal Care Service”, as a considered use to the M2 – Light Industrial High Density zone. In addition, the definition is to be amended to provide the opportunity to potentially utilize outdoor space, the use shall be listed as “permitted” in both the M2 – Light Industrial High Density and M3 – Light Industrial Business District zones, and a parking requirement shall be added. Adding the use to the M2 zone and making the appropriate amendments allows the public the opportunity to apply to operate “Animal Care Services” in more locations within the City, and facilitates the means by which Administration is to review each new application.

**Therefore, City Council, at its meeting to be held on June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at 5:00 p.m., will consider all submissions both written and verbal respecting the Public Hearing for the above bylaw. If you would like your written submission reviewed by City Council PRIOR to the meeting, it would be preferable to provide your submission by 4:45 p.m. on Tuesday June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2016. In accordance with City Council’s Procedure Bylaw No. 26 of 2014, any written submissions must be provided to the City Clerk. Verbal submissions shall be heard during the Public Hearing portion of the meeting.**
