



# CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT PUBLIC NOTICE

## ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT – BYLAW NO. 15 OF 2017

Public Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Prince Albert intends to consider Bylaw No. 15 of 2017 to amend Bylaw No. 1 of 1987, known as the City of Prince Albert Zoning Bylaw.

**Reason for the Amendment:** At the City Council meeting held June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017, Bylaw No. 15 of 2017 received first reading and Administration was authorized to provide Public Notification for a Public Hearing. Bylaw No. 15 of 2017 proposes to amend the Billboard and Permanent Sign Regulations and Schedule “A” of Section 32 of the City of Prince Albert Zoning Bylaw. Schedule “A” identifies publicly owned locations throughout the City that City Council has authority to enter into Licensing Agreements with private businesses so they may install and operate Billboards for a specified period of time. Currently, Schedule “A” of Section 32 of the City of Prince Albert Zoning Bylaw identifies seven (7) locations; Bylaw No. 15 of 2017 proposes to add one (1) additional location at Glass Field Municipal Airport which will accommodate two (2) new billboards.

**Therefore, City Council, at its meeting to be held on Monday, July 17th, 2017 at 2:00 p.m., will consider all submissions both written and verbal respecting the Public Hearing for the above bylaw. If you would like your written submission reviewed by City Council PRIOR to the meeting, it would be preferable if it were provided by 4:45 p.m. on Tuesday, July 11th, 2017. In accordance with City Council’s Procedure Bylaw No. 26 of 2014, any written submissions must be provided to the City Clerk. Verbal submissions shall be heard during the Public Hearing portion of the meeting.**
