City of Prince Albert Purchasing Policy - Amendment

The City of Prince Albert hereby gives notice, pursuant to Section 102 of *The Cities Act* and the Public Notice Policy Bylaw No. 24 of 2015, of its intention to revise its' Purchasing Policy.

Reason for Change: The reason for the amendment to the Purchasing Policy is to clarify the discretionary powers City Council is able to exercise with respect to Tendering, calling for Request for Proposals and negotiated Multi-Year Contracts in a manner, which is consistent with the requirements of the Cities Act.

The proposed amendment includes:

"With respect to Tendering or Bids, Request for Proposals and Multi-Year Contracts, in all cases where it does not contravene federal or provincial legislation governing the City, the City reserves the right to refuse any or all Tenders, Bids or Proposals where the City deems it to be in the best interests of the City to do so having regard, but no limited to, questions of quality supply and service, timelines, performance trustworthiness, solvency, monies owing or due to the City and the existence or potential of legal disputes or conflicts with the City of Prince Albert."
