



CITY OF PRINCE ALBERT PUBLIC NOTICE

ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT – BYLAW NO. 24 OF 2018

Public Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Prince Albert intends to consider Bylaw No. 24 of 2018 to amend Bylaw No. 1 of 1987, known as the City of Prince Albert Zoning Bylaw.

Reason for the Amendment: At the City Council meeting held July 16th, 2018, first reading of Bylaw No. 24 of 2018 was given and Administration was authorized to provide Public Notification for a Public Hearing. Bylaw 24 of 2018 proposes to define the following new land uses: Cannabis Retail Store, Cannabis Production Facility, and Cannabis Wholesale.

Bylaw 24 of 2018 also proposes to establish regulations pertaining to the above mentioned land uses, such as:

- The Zoning Districts each land use may be permitted to operate within;
- A 200 metre offset of Cannabis Retail Stores from Elementary Schools, High Schools and Parks; and,
- Special considerations City Council may have to minimize noxious or offensive emissions from those land uses.

Therefore, City Council, at its meeting to be held on Tuesday, August 7th at 2:00 p.m., will consider all submissions both written and verbal respecting the Public Hearing for the above bylaw. If you would like your written submission reviewed by City Council PRIOR to the meeting, it would be preferable if it were provided by 4:45 p.m. on Tuesday, July 31st, 2018. In accordance with City Council's Procedure Bylaw No. 26 of 2014, any written submissions must be provided to the City Clerk. Verbal submissions shall be heard during the Public Hearing portion of the meeting.
