ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT – BYLAW NO. 17 OF 2018

Public Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Prince Albert intends to consider Bylaw No. 17 of 2018 to amend Bylaw No. 1 of 1987, known as the City of Prince Albert Zoning Bylaw.

Reason for the Amendment: At the City Council meeting held April 16th, 2018, first reading of Bylaw No. 17 of 2018 was given and Administration was authorized to provide Public Notification for a Public Hearing. Bylaw No. 17 of 2018 proposes to add the land use “Gas Bar” to M2 – Light Industrial High Density zones.

Gas Bar is defined as:

“a commercial facility predominantly for the sale of gasoline, diesel and propane fuel and may offer for sale other petroleum products and automotive accessories.”

Therefore, City Council, at its meeting to be held on Monday, May 7th, 2018 at 5:00 p.m., will consider all submissions both written and verbal respecting the Public Hearing for the above bylaw. If you would like your written submission reviewed by City Council PRIOR to the meeting, it would be preferable if it were provided by 4:45 p.m. on Tuesday, May 1st, 2018. In accordance with City Council’s Procedure Bylaw No. 26 of 2014, any written submissions must be provided to the City Clerk. Verbal submissions shall be heard during the Public Hearing portion of the meeting.
