



PRE-QUALIFICATION OF GENERAL CONTRACTORS FOR HIGHWAY 3 OVER HIGHWAY 2 OVERPASS GIRDER HEAT STRAIGHTENING AND GENERAL REPAIRS, PRINCE ALBERT, SK

Request for Prequalification No. 13947

Prequalification Submissions, contained within sealed packaging and clearly marked with the Respondent's Name, Address, Pre-qualification Number, and closing date, will be received at the office of the Public Works Department, City of Prince Albert, 1084 Central Avenue, no later than 2:00 PM (CST), May 20, 2014. All prequalification submissions must include fully completed Pre-Qualification Submission Forms, which are available electronically in PDF form upon request from the City of Prince Albert, at no charge to prospective respondents.

The intent of this Pre-Qualification process is to identify up to three general contractors who will be short-listed to provide Firm Upset Pricing for the project; the lowest responsive bidder shall enter into a construction contract with the City of Prince Albert to complete the overpass repairs. General Contractors must seek interest from a qualified heat straightening contractor as part of their submission, and will be expected to subcontract with their selected company to provide the heat straightening services included within the scope-of-work. Due to the specialized qualifications required for the heat straightening tasks, qualified heat straightening contractors will be granted permission to support multiple general contracting teams.

The project scope-of-work includes but is not limited to the preparation of girder areas experiencing localized section loss; the application of flame controlled heat straightening techniques; the repair of distorted girders, diaphragms, gussets, and localized flange/web distortions; guardrail restoration; abutment/wingwall washout remediation, expansion joint gland replacement; concrete and asphalt repairs, and the application of silane sealers to concrete surfaces.

Administrative inquiries must be directed in writing only (letter, fax, or e-mail) to the City of Prince Albert, up to and including 1:00 PM May 5th, 2014. All questions will be provided with written responses no later than 5:00 PM May 12th, 2014.
