# GARBAGE & RECYCLING BINS

Waste Collection and Disposal Bylaw No. 8 of 2018

BYLAW RESPONSIBILITIES

Curbside bins left on the street are at a greater risk of vandalism and get in the way of on-street parking spaces.

LEAVING YOUR BIN ON THE CURB OR BACK LANE PUTS YOU AT RISK FOR A FINE.

Fines: 1st offence: \$100

2nd offence: \$200

## **GARBAGE AND RECYCLING PICK-UP**

To be picked up, garbage and recycling bins need to be placed out on the front curb of your property (or back lane if applicable).

### IMPORTANT TIMES TO NOTE:

### Before your bin is picked up

Bins must be put out before 7:30a.m. on your collection day. Bins can also be put out the day before your collection day anytime after 4:00pm.

# After your bin is picked up

Bins must be removed from the curb and placed back onto your property before noon the day after your collection day.

# **COLLECTION CALENDARS**

Garbage and recycling collection calendars are delivered door-to-door in November or December each year. You can also find a copy of the pick-up schedule at www.citypa.ca/wastepickup
