# Important Notice from the Prince Albert Fire Department

Please.....



Stay safe from fire!

The Prince Albert Fire Department wants you to know that there have been many encampment fires in Prince Albert. Belongings have been destroyed and people have suffered serious injuries.

This is what you can do to ensure you are not seriously injured or killed by fire.

- Absolutely no open fires of any kind (not for any reason...inside or outside your tent).
- No fuel such as propane, butane, or gasoline is permitted.
- Never smoke in your tent or sleeping bag...go outside
- Don't carelessly flick or throw cigarette butts and matches away.
- Remember that sleeping bags are combustible... they can easily catch fire and burn.
- Tents and tarps are extremely combustible and very dangerous to sleep in, when a heating source is in use.

**Is the shelter safe?**

**Yes, Stepping Stones helps keep you safe by making sure:**



→ **There's no abuse, violence, harassment of others, and staff.**

→ **There's no consumption of cigarettes, vapes, alcohol, or illicit substances.**

→ **Everyone is respectful towards one another, the shelter, and staff.**

**Can I bring my belongings?**

**Yes, once you arrive, you'll be provided a bin for your belongings.**
