- Never smoke in your tent or sleeping bag...go outside
- Don't carelessly flick or throw cigarette butts and matches away.
- Remember that sleeping bags are combustible... they can easily catch fire and burn.
- Tents and tarps are extremely combustible and very dangerous to sleep in, when a heating source is in use.




